Uk companies looking to cut jobs to save costs

UK companies will increasingly make staff redundant as a way of cutting costs, a survey by the Bank of England's regional agents has suggested. The survey, conducted in December, showed that having already pared back non-labour costs as much as possible during the recession, many business services contacts now felt that they would be forced to reduce staff numbers.

The survey has also showed that companies have further curbed their investment intentions. The report, used by

BOE policy makers as an up-to-date signal on economic conditions, adds to the gloom on the UK economy after official figures showed that output shrank by 0.2% in the final three months of 2011.

This coincides with a report from the British Bankers' Association that showed UK bank lending to businesses fell in December, as companies became more cautious about the economic outlook, and banks found it more difficult to raise funds.
